Captain Chesley “Sully” Sullenberger (1951-) of Denison, Texas, currently living in Danvill, California became a household name for successfully landing US Airways Flight 1549 in the Hudson River in New York City, 15 January 2009, saving the lives of all 155 people onboard. The flight was enroute from New York's LaGuardia Airport to Charlotte/Douglas International Airport in Charlotte, North Carolina when it was hit by a flock of birds, disabling both engines.
